3. Entries can be typed or handwritten.
4. There is no limit to the number of entries.
5. Closing date for the competition is 31st March 2009
6. Eligibility for each age category is determined by the closing date (eg Under 12 years on 31st March 2009)
7. Judges reserve the right to not award prizes in every category.
8. Your name and address must not appear on any pages of your entry. The official entry form should be attached to your entry by a clip or alternatively you may write your details on a separate piece of paper and attach that.
9. Copies of the winning entries will be kept at Kadina Community Library and will be published with Kernewek Lowender information on the District Council of the Copper Coast website. 10. Individual winners will be notified by mail and presentations will be made at a ceremony during the Kernewek Lowender Festival after which time results will be published in the YP Country Times.
