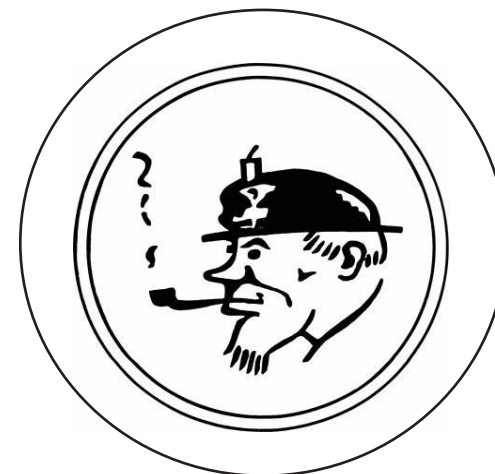

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entries close 12 midnight on Friday 1st May 2009. Entries will not be included without a signed entry form and entry fee payment. Entry forms may be photocopied and/or faxed.
- Each entry is subject to a \$10 (GST inclusive) non-refundable entry fee.
- Exhibitors may enter two works. In the event there is insufficient hanging space for all entries, we reserve the right to conduct a ballot to determine which of the second-nominated works are to be exhibited. Paired works are classed as single entries. All entries will be required for the whole of the exhibition period, at the coordinators discretion. Please note: No ballot has been held to this date.
- All entries submitted must be for sale. A 25% commission (plus GST where applicable) will be charged.
- Completed entry forms, together with fees, should be forwarded to: The Art Prize Coordinator, 50 Moonta Road, KADINA 5554.
- Artists should include a signed proforma declaration that they are "not carrying on an enterprise", an "exempt hobby artist only", or else provide an ABN number. If the above are not included with the entry form 48.5% of sale cost will be taken out of sales.
- The artwork must be ORIGINAL, UNCOPIED & UNSUPERVISED; and must have been executed by the artist during the two (2) years prior to the exhibition. Work should be suitably framed or on stretched canvas and ready for hanging, with screw and wire situated 1/3 from the top of the frame. Rods and cord for alternate media must be strong and secure. Free standing 3D works must be balanced and secure.
- Overall size of visual hanging work, inclusive of frame, or rods and cord must be limited to 1.5m x 1.5m. Free standing 3D works must be within the base measurement of 30cm x 42cm (A3 paper) x 61cm high and wide.
- All work must be clearly identified on the back (or base of free standing 3D works) with the submission label (included on this form) firmly attached.
- All entries will be included in the "Open Art Award" unless otherwise indicated.
- The Judges will see all work submitted within entry conditions, but not every work will automatically be selected for exhibition. No correspondence will be entered into.
- Kernewek Lowender Inc. reserves the right to have any work reproduced for media promotion.
- Kernewek Lowender Inc. will exercise all reasonable care with exhibits submitted but accepts no responsibility for loss or damage. Adequate precautions must be taken when packing works. FREIGHT AND LIABILITY COVER IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ARTIST. Best endeavours will be undertaken to deliver and return in good order and on time. Packing should be strong and suitable for return (bubble plastic wrapping with cardboard outer cover).
- Work can be personally delivered to the entrance of the 'Copper Coast Ascot Arts Centre' at 48 Graves Street, Kadina on Saturday 2nd May and Sunday 3rd May 2009 between 11am and 3pm on both days.
- Unsold works can be collected between 4pm and 6pm on Monday 18th May and between 11am and 3pm on Tuesday 19th May 2009. Identification will be required to collect works.
- Unclaimed works will be returned at the written directions and expense of the Artist (unless otherwise arranged with the Coordinator) within fourteen (14) days, or will become the property of Kernewek Lowender Inc.
- In the event of a dispute regarding the interpretation of the Conditions Of Entry, the decision of the Kernewek Lowender will be final and binding on all parties concerned.
